Unfortunately, the meeting room, while a little larger than the last room we met in at the Council of Governments office, with current health guidelines only 25 people can be in the room. With council members, staff and people who need to give reports we are at 25. Marion County officials have told us they will have to turn away people once 25 people have entered the room.
