

Witness Affirmation Instructions

These 2 witness affirmation forms are confirmation of:

1. Your name
2. Who your parents are
3. Where you live
4. Where you were born
5. When you were born
6. What you look like

This gives you 2 testimonies that this information is correct and validates your claim.

Things needed:

- (2) Copies of the affirmation forms
- Passport photos (these are available at most CVS/Walgreens locations for \$12 per photo)
- These are very specific in their composition and biometrically digitized
- It is recommended that you get 3 photos. (2 for your witness affirmations/ 1 for an actual passport application to be filed later in the process)
- 2 living people

Your 2 witnesses can be friends, family, employers, or anyone that has known you for some time and can validate simple information about you such as where you live, what you look like, your full name, etc. It is not recommended to have strangers that you will never see again do this. If these documents are ever brought into question, you want to be able to validate them.

Recording Options:

- Meet each witness/both at a local notary at a time convenient for them
- Have both witnesses attend the recording meeting, and fill them out in front of your State or County Recording Secretary

Lines in yellow can be filled out at anytime

Lines in teal need to be filled out and signed in front of the Notary or Recording Secretary
