
Message

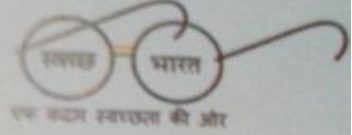



I am also happy to learn that various participants from different schools, colleges and general youth will also be presented various awards, mementos and proficiency certificates on 18th December, 2016.

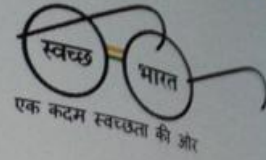
I understand that this event will serve as an effective way of inculcating appreciation for music in children and youth and encourage them to showcase their potentials in this field.
