

Some interesting facts you may not have known about the 4th of July:

- ♦ We did not declare independence from Great Britain on July 4th; it was actually July 2nd. In fact, John Adams expected July 2nd to be our national independence day.
- ♦ The Declaration of Independence was not signed on July 4th, 1776; it was signed by 56 different people over a six-month period. And most of them signed on August 2nd, 1776. It was formally ADOPTED by the Continental Congress on July 4th.
- ♦ The first public reading of the Declaration was on July 8th, 1776 in Philadelphia. They rang the Liberty Bell to summon people to Independence Hall for the reading.
- ♦ John McKean was the last person to sign the Declaration, in January of 1777.
- ♦ The word "patriotism" comes from the Latin word "patria," meaning "fatherland." So if you're a patriotic American, you're saying the United States is your FATHERLAND.
- ♦ Both Thomas Jefferson and John Adams died on the 50th anniversary of the first Independence Day July 4th, 1826.
- ♦ Congress didn't make the Fourth a federal holiday until 1941.
- According to legend, the iconic "American face stuffing competition" began in 1916, when four immigrants argued over who was the most patriotic, and somehow decided the best way to figure it out was by seeing who could shove the most hot dogs inside of them.
