





#### PINOT NOIR, JOEL GOTT, WILLAMETTE VALLEY, OREGON \$51

Aromas of cola and black raspberry, framed by hints of sweet oak and vanilla on the nose. This elegant, well-structured wine melds velvety tannins with a fresh fruit character.

# MERLOT, CHARLES SMITH VELVET DEVIL', COLUMBIA VALLEY, WASHINGTON STATE \$9\\$34

This merlot has rich aromas of ripe red berry fruit and bing cherry, along with notes of dried harbs. Flavors of red cherries, cola, cloves and spice dominate the palate, with just a hint of toasty oak thrown in.

#### MALBEC, ACHAVAL FERRER, MENDOZA, ARGENTINA \$10 | \$38

Bright violet in color, this wine is fresh and floral, featuring blackberry, plums and violets on the nose and palate. The wine is soft and round with a noticeable minerality. Silky tannins mark a lengthy finish.

# SYRAH, CHARLES SMITH 'BOOM BOOM', WASHINGTON STATE \$9 | \$34

Complexity, tannis inferior to none. Blackberry, boysenberry, dry-hung meat, white pepper, savory herbs, crushed granite.

# CABERNET SAUVIGNON, JAM CELLARS, CALIFORNIA \$12|\$46

Classic cabernet sauvignon favors of black cherries with subtle hints of baking spiace dance across the palate, bolstered by fine, round tannins. This medium bodied wine is soft in mouth feel, yet long on the fruit characted and finish.

# THE PRISONER RED BLEND, NAPA, CALIFORNIA \$88

Primarily red zinfandel with cabernet sauvignon and syrah, it has aromas of bing cherry, dark chocolate, clove, and roasted fig. Persistent flavors of ripe raspberry, boysenberry, pomegranate, and vanilla linger harmoniously, for a smooth and luscious finish.

# GEKKEIKAN, JUNMAI, CALIFORNIA 10 OZ. CARAFE \$10

Hernaceous with hints of grapefruit and a light eathiness. Good acidity, mineral driver, well-balanced with a clean, medium finish.

#### **GEKKEIKAN KOBAI PLUM WINE \$8**

Notes of almond and apple blossom enhance the natural plum flavor, while honey and meyer lemon lace round out the finish.
