PINOT GRIGIO, ESPERTO, IGT, DELLE VENEZIE, ITALY \$8|\$30

Intense, clean notes of meadow flowers, then powerful citrus, pears and pleasant hints of golden apple.

SAUVIGNON BLANC, 13 CELSIUS, MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND \$8|\$30

There are hints of grapefruit, gooseberry and citrus, and comes together with a long, creamy finish.

ALBARINO, RAMON BILBAO, SPAIN \$42

Golden straw color with green hues, and exceptional, bright and aromatic wine with sumptuous flavors of pineapple, lychee and minerals, Spain's sunniest white wine.

CHARDONNAY, CHARLES SMITH 'EVE', WASHINGTON ST \$10|\$38

This is a fresh, soft style of chardonnay with bright sweet citrus fruit character and subtle spice and oak nuances.

CHARDONNAY, EN ROUTE BY FAR NIENTE, RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY, SONOMA, CALIFORNIA \$78

Barrel fermented and aged sur lies to create a rich, smooth, food-friendly wine with subtle hints of oak and crisp flavors of lemon, peach and melon. It has classic chardonnay qualities with a bright and refreshing finish.

WHITE BLEND, BLINDFOLD BY THE PRISONER, CALIFORNIA \$45

A blend of chardonnay for structure and a variety of rhone valley white grapes for aromatics. The resulting wine shows inviting aromas of honeysuckle, grilled white peach, and apricot. A luscious entry of toasted hazelnut and mandarin are balanced by bright acidity and minerality. The finish is rich and creamy with flavors of lemon zest and caramelized sugar.

RIESLING, 'KUNG FU GIRL', COLUMBIA VALLEY, WASHINGTON STATE \$9|\$34

Bright floral notes and whispers of sweetness finishing with tropical fruits.

ROSÉ WINES

FLEURS DE PRAIRIE, PROVENCE, FRANCE \$10|\$38

Crafted in the traditional provençal style (dry), fleurs de prairie is a pale salmon color with delicate flavors of strawberry, rose petals and herbs. Its bright, refreshing acidity makes it a perfect companion with a meal or as an aperitif.
