Please abide by the following rules in order to ensure a safe camping adventure for everyone. Mountainview Campground LLC reserves the right to refuse service to anyone and will not be responsible for accidents or injury to our guests or for loss of property of any kind. We reserve the right to evict - without refund – any camper or group deemed to create a nuisance or disturbance or to be in violation of the following rules. In addition, all state and local laws apply.

- Speed Limit 5 MPH. Drive slowly and cautiously throughout the campground.
- Quiet Hours from 10:00 PM 8:00 AM. No loud noise, loud music or indecent language at any time.
- Check-in and Check-out Times: Check-in time is 3:00 PM, and checkout time is 12:00 Noon. If you are staying for 2 or more nights, we allow check-out as late as 6.00 PM
- Damages / Vandalism: When checking out, please ensure that your campsite is left in the same clean condition that you found upon arrival. Charges may be incurred in extreme instances.
- Air Conditioners / Electric Heaters: Extra charge for air conditioners is \$3.00 per day. Absolutely no electric heaters may be used!
- Trees: Do not cut, deface, or insert nails into our trees.
- Firewood: Do not collect firewood in the woods or fields. Firewood is sold in our store. In order to prevent the spread of invasive insect species, firewood may not be brought in from out of state.
- Water Usage: No washing of vehicles at your campsite.
- Campfires: Do not move fire rings without permission. Maintain campfire at safe level. Never leave your campfire unattended.
- Pets: Keep pets on a leash at all times. They must be kept quiet, and you must clean up after them. No pets in bathrooms or swimming area. Limit of 2 pets per site, unless alternate arrangements are made with management in advance.
- No Mini Bikes, ATVs or Golf Carts. In addition, motorcycles may only be ridden in the campground when entering or exiting your site.
- Trash: Please put trash in plastic bags and place in designated containers for disposal. Cans and bottles must be recycled, and you will find recycling containers located throughout the campground for this purpose. No disposal of household trash. Only conventional trash that was generated during the course of your stay should be deposited in our trash containers.

- Registration: Everyone, both campers and visitors, must stop by the office Guests: Our base rates include 2 adults. All others are guests and must check in at the office before entering the campground. Only seasonal campers are allowed to invite guests. Campers are responsible for their guests' fees. Guests must check out no later than 10:00 PM or will be considered overnight guests, with additional fees applicable.
 - Maximum Site Occupancy: No more than 8 adults per site, including guests. Other accommodations require advance management approval.
 - Alcohol & Smoking: The consumption of alcohol and the use of tobacco products must be done in a responsible manner, by persons of legal age, and in total compliance with state laws and respect for fellow campers.
 - Firearms: Firearms and other weapons are prohibited, including BB guns. Fireworks are prohibited.
 - Power Tools: No power tools or chainsaws.
 - Parental Supervision: Persons under 18 years of age are not allowed to camp without supervision.
 - Children: Parents are solely responsible for the safety and supervision of their children. Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult when using the restrooms or visiting the ponds.
 - Bicycles: No bicycle riding after dark. Children are required to wear helmets, and all state safety regulations will apply.
 - Seasonal Trailers: All trailers must be approved by management before being brought into the campground.
 - Non-Transferable: Your campsite is for your use only. It is not to be used by relatives or friends in your absence.
 - Deposits: A one night deposit is required at the time of booking. A two night deposit is required for holiday weekends.
 - Cancellations & Refunds: No refunds for no-shows. With the exception of holidays, we will issue a credit on the deposit that may be used up to one month after the arrival date of the original reservation.ds.
 - Management reserves the right to modify these rules at any time.
