
Each of the easements we accept is a distinctive donation by a landowner as a permanent gift of exclusive property rights for Broad Water to maintain and steward in perpetuity. We work in the service of environmental health, lifelong conservation and for the public benefit. We seek to build a partnership with the landowners of these eased properties though regular communications and property visits to ensure that the land's conservation values continue to be protected as intended.

PURPOSES

Broad Water exists to acquire, hold, maintain, conserve and protect land or land interests in perpetuity and to provide and preserve outdoor recreation, natural open space and biodiversity.
