Newgrange and Ross Castle



Kilkenny & Smithwick's Experience

HEAD TO THE SMALL, HISTORIC CITY OF KILKENNY FOR A GUIDED WALKING TOUR ALONG ITS MEDIEVAL MILE TO EXPERIENCE ITS RICH HERITAGE, NARROW STREETSCAPES, AND WELL-PRESERVED MERCHANTS' HOUSES. STOP AT ONE OF ITS CLASSIC PUBS. SMELL THE HOPS AND ENJOY A SAMPLE ON A TOUR OF SMITHWICK'S EXPERIENCE, TELLING THE STORY OF THE POPULAR BREWERY IN THE HEART OF THE CITY SINCE 1710. Blarney Castle & Killarney

DAY 6 OCT. 20 Cliffs of Moher and Galway

EMBARK ON A FERRY RIDE ACROSS THE WIDE RIVER SHANNON ESTUARY. TAKE IN THE SPECTACULAR BEAUTY OF THE CLIFFS OF MOHER, SOARING 700 FEET ABOVE THE ATLANTIC SURF. 




DAY 8 OCT. 22









