INTRODUCTION



The NRA Basic Pistol Course goal is to teach the basic knowledge, skills, and attitude for owning and operating a pistol safely. This includes both classroom and range time. The instructor will ensure shooters have met the learning objectives before successfully completing the course which includes a basic NRA pistol qualification. Student-to-instructor ratio during the fundamentals course is preferred to be 1/5 participation. The key to course success and a positive training experience is total participant involvement. *People learn by doing!*

***This courser emphasizes firearm safety and overall gun owner's responsibilities**

COURSE OBJECTIVE

You will learn NRA's rules for safe gun handling; pistol parts and operation, ammunition, shooting fundamentals, range rules, shooting from benchrest and standing positions, cleaning pistols, and continued opportunities for skill development. In order to earn a certificate from NRA, you will be required to shoot five-shot groups within a four inch circle from 10-15 feet in distance.

LESSON 2: AMMUNITION KNOWLEDGE & FUNDAMENTALS OF PISTOL SHOOTING

LESSON 4: SCORING TARGETS & SELECTING AND MAINTAINING YOUR PISTOL

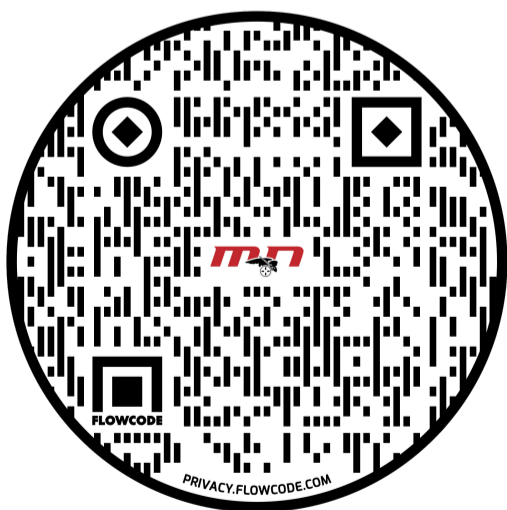
LESSON 5: CONTINUED OPPORTUNITIES FOR SKILL DEVELOPMENT

Please do NOT bring loaded firearms to training. All firearms must be unloaded, secured in a closed container with ammunition in a separate container prior to arriving. Staff will verify all firearms are unloaded prior to starting the class. A safety brief will be provided at the start of the class and is available at www.MNShooting.com



All shooters will be required to sign and date a release, waiver, indemnification, hold harmless and assumption of risk agreement prior to the course. MNSHOOTING, LLC will provide the form and collect at the beginning of the course.
