

The President's fandom resulted in several invitations to **The White House**. Later, White House advisors saw an opportunity and sought Yakov's help and advice during the tense meetings between The President and Soviet leader **Mikhail Gorbachev**.

Yakov's insight and comedic contributions greatly helped thaw relations between the two leaders—building a genuine rapport between both them and their delegations.

Those first

marked the beginning of the end of the Cold War, and ultimately of the Soviet Union's socialist empire.

For Yakov, it was the role of a lifetime. He grew up in **Joseph Stalin's USSR**, his family sharing a small apartment with eight other families. Somehow, he was able to find joy in making others laugh. After two years of required service in the Soviet Army, he landed a comedy job on a cruise ship, yet always under the watchful eye of **the KGB and Soviet authorities** who carefully reviewed all his material.

After two years of paperwork, Yakov and his family were finally allowed to emigrate to America. They arrived in New York with less than a hundred dollars in their pockets.

As always, Yakov's comedy draws from the news and from life—ours as well as his. But that's not all. While making us "laugh our Yakov," the famous Russian comedian also causes many a heart to swell with pride and gratitude for the country we live in, and for the faith, hope and love that made it great.

Yakov got his start in American funny business at the famed Comedy Store in Los

Angeles, where legendary owner Mitzi Shore showcased Yakov and fellow struggling comics such as **David Letterman**, **Jay Leno**, **Robin Williams**, **Richard Pryor**, **Jim Carrey** and others.

TV: Has appeared on virtually every major network entertainment show.



HE can ultimately force a detour. What a blessing to be reminded that we are not in control. The stress of trying to have it all figured out is truly more weight than any one person can bear. God is ultimately the master planner of our destiny. We are so thankful He is, because in a

time that seemed so uncertain, we knew exactly who to look to for direction.

When we returned to stage in June, we did not know what to expect. We had to learn an entirely new way of running our business. How would we social distance? How would we protect our cast and crew? Would anyone come or even feel safe to travel and see a show? These were all questions scrutinized in the days leading up to our re-opening. It felt like every day brought a new worry. There was one thing that was a constant, however, and that was God. We knew we were not alone in the journey. He would bring us the answers.

We worked together with our staff to develop a safe and effective method for social distancing. We created protocol for protecting our cast and crew with temperature checks and masks. We waited each day at the box office as we have done for sixty years, believing that there is no virus too big to keep God-fearing folks from living life and enjoying live music entertainment. Guess what? We made it through. Now, it wasn't easy. There were days that were difficult, but in those difficulties, we found blessing. We were reminded of how thankful we are for our talents that allow us to make a living. We were reminded of how thankful we are for our guests. We were reminded of how thankful we are for our city of Branson. Living in a place that allows us to do what we love each and every night—pandemic or no pandemic—is a gift.

Above anything, we were reminded of how thankful we are for a God who gently reminds us to remember our blessings—sometimes in big ways. 2020 has reminded us that faith over fear is always the way to live life. Nothing is too hard and no problem is too big for a God who already sees the finish line. As we end this year, we will continue believing in God's all-knowing ways. He will provide. He will bless. He will lead where our eyes cannot see.



Garry Carson reigned in Vegas. His magic astounded viewers on network TV and dazzled multitudes on world tours with his huge entourage of stage hands, props, performing assistants and (shall we mention?) a supporting cast of tigers, leopards and other wildcats that Vegas legend Roy Horn (of Sigfried & Roy) helped him train. Besides entertaining, Garry built illusions for other magicians, David Copperfield being one of many. But then, everything changed.

A Whole New World!

After performing his show on a cruise ship in Hawaii, Garry was approached at the post show "meet'n' greet" by a Mom, a Grandma, two Aunts, and a young lady with them who immediately caught his eye. Turns out, like him, the young lady lived back in Vegas, a town that allowed the New York native to pursue all her interests, and even bring life to some of her dreams. She was an EMT nurse. That was her passion. But since

childhood, she also loved to perform. That interest led to a side hobby of modeling, (often as a Vegas showgirl), and eventually, as a costume designer: a craft she surely has mastered, (as us audience types will verify). For both of these two, it was the beginning of a whole new world.

Vegas & Beyond!

Back in Vegas, they reunited. First came love, then came marriage, then came this amazing twosome making magic together all over the world—Janine performing with her husband, designing costumes, managing a blizzard of showbiz details—

and eventually adding "backstage Mom" to her resume. That came about by the birth of **Sophia**, now 3 years old. Which, once again, changed everything.

"By the time Sophia was sixteen months old," as Garry told *The Insider*, "she had been on 42 planes and had a handful of passports and visas. We felt it was time to slow down a bit. The illusions are incredible, the magician

and his wife are lovable, and Garry is non-stop hilarious! But here's what's really special: the show is rapid-fire, funny and astounding, but not at all hyper. In fact, it's so relaxed and casual that audiences are stunned when the 90 minutes are over! (No intermission. Just woosh! And it's over!) Dinner at 5, show gets out by 7. Then it's woosh! On to an 8pm show elsewhere, or woosh, back to the lodging to just kick back and chill.



The Shock

Magic shows are notorious for attracting many in the audience who greatly fear being invited up on stage, dressed like they are, to be embarrassingly fooled in public. Many request tables at the back of the dinner theater to avoid becoming part of the show. Nice try. Like every show, many in the audience are seen with arms crossed,

waiting to see if they can be entertained or not—but within minutes, you can literally feel the ice breaking. In a flash, the atmosphere becomes as relaxing as a private party at home with friends. And here's proof—when Garry asks for volunteers, many raise their hands and some hide—but by show's end, all he has to do is hold out his hand. No words. And his volunteer immediately stands up, takes his hand, and follows him to the stage. It's that kind of atmosphere and Garry is that kind of guy.

Years ago Garry founded a charity which has long since outgrown him and to this day works a different kind of magic throughout the world. His heart for people less fortunate has dominated his life since childhood.

Growing up in Fountain, Colorado, Garry immediately demonstrated amazing physical skills. Early on, coaches predicted he would have a stellar sports career. His dream was to play in the NFL. (Denver Broncos, for example!) But that all changed when a sledding accident nearly took his life and left him with injuries that made sports of any kind literally life threatening. His childhood was marred by other traumas—as both his mother and his brother battled near-fatal health problems.

With those experiences, Garry quickly saw opportunities to "give back" in the world of show business. 

"He didn't put himself up on a pedestal. He loved people. He was such a giving person. There will never be another Elvis."


