



Bolts High Performance Parental Code of Conduct

AS THE PARENT/GUARDIAN OF A PLAYER IN THE BOLTS HIGH PERFORMANCE PROGRAM I WILL NOT

1. Force my child to participate in the game of soccer
2. Coach my child from the sidelines either in games or during training sessions
3. Yell at or argue with referees
4. Criticize or make disparaging remarks about other teammates, coaches or officials
5. Engage in any negative behaviour directed at opposing players, parents, officials
6. Approach the coach/trainer with an impending issue less than 30 minutes before a session unless agreed
7. Approach the coach/trainer with an impending issue less than 24hrs after the completion of a game
8. Emphasise winning over development and understand the difference
9. Criticize BOLTS HIGH PERFORMANCE (BHP) in a public forum, through social media outlets or news media, instead I will submit my concerns in writing to the appropriate club official giving them 5 business days to respond

AS THE PARENT/GUARDIAN OF A PLAYER IN THE BOLTS HIGH PERFORMANCE PROGRAM I WILL

10. Encourage good sportsmanship by showing positive support for all players, coaches and officials at all games and practice sessions
11. Support the coaches and trainers working with my child, to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all involved
12. Place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of my personal desire to "WIN" or prioritize "Results" over "Performance"
13. Remember that this is a "Youth" soccer program for the benefit of the youth not the "Adults"
14. Ensure that my child treats all players, coaches, trainers, opponents and officials with respect
15. Ensure that my child understands our No Bullying & Player Code of Conduct Policy
16. Ensure my child attends all training sessions and games giving at least 24 hrs notice if absence will occur whenever possible
17. Get my player to training ready to start at least five minutes before the scheduled start time
18. Get my player to each home game at least 35 minutes before kickoff
19. Get my player to each away game at least 45 minutes before kickoff
20. Follow the tournament itinerary for all local or travel tournaments
21. Let the coaches coach, the referees ref and the players play
22. Provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in the BOLTS HIGH PERFORMANCE (BHP) program by adhering to the Parent Code of Conduct

Parents or Guardians registering their players with BOLTS HIGH PERFORMANCE (BHP) agree to the above Parents Code of Conduct and understand that my (our) failure to uphold any of these statements may result in disciplinary action by the Board of Directors or the Coaches, which may include, but is not limited to, monetary sanctions, forfeiture of my (our) right to attend and watch my child participate in any training, practice sessions, game, tournament, club event, or dismissal from the program.
